

Homework

Each week your child will receive:
Maths Homework
Reading
Spellings.

Homework will be given out in your child's homework book on a Wednesday and collected in on a Monday morning. It would be appreciated if you could take the time to help your child learn their spellings at home as each child receives an individual spelling pack.

Children should also read at home every night to an adult. This should be recorded in their planner. Reading bags and planners should be brought to school every day and taken home every night. Reading and library books will be changed on a Monday morning.

Reminder.

PE kits should be brought into school in a drawstring bag at the start of term and remain at school until the end of term. This should include a T-shirt (not a football shirt), plain black shorts and plimsolls.

Literacy

As our topic is Fantastic Mr Fox, this half term we will be looking at character descriptions using the story. We also will be looking at ways of writing our own information texts.

Maths

We will be refining number skills and learning about place value. Children in Year 1 will become confident with their number bonds to 20. Children in Year 2 will extend their knowledge of number bonds to numbers up to 50. All children will further their addition and subtraction skills.

Science.

During this half term, the children will be looking similarities and differences between animals. They will be looking at the habitat of a fox and ways in which a fox has adapted to its environment.

R.E.

The children will be discussing their views about The Bible and learning about The Church.

P.E.

During this half term, the children will be learning gymnastic skills. They will be developing different techniques used in games.

SEAL

The theme for this half term is New Beginnings.

ICT

In ICT we will be making maps and controlling a floor turtle to arrive at a given destination.

Music
