

Reception

Children will be learning through play at school this half term and engaging in short focused activities with an adult as well as focusing on their sounds on a daily basis. Your child will soon get a reading book (initially without words) and a copy of their new sounds which will be in their black homework book to practise at home.

Your child can also record something they have done over the weekend on a page in their homework book. This could be a picture or a photograph or something that they have collected.

Year 1

Each week (starting on Monday) your child will receive:

Homework will be given out in your child's black homework book on a Friday and collected in on a Monday morning. Spellings are given out on a Monday for the following Friday. It would be appreciated if you could take the time to help your child learn their spellings at home.

Children should also read at home whenever possible to an adult. This should be recorded in their planner. Reading bags and planners should be brought to school every day and taken home every night.

Reminder.

PE kits should be brought into school in a drawstring bag at the start of term and remain at school until the end of the half-term.

Children will also need to bring a pair of wellies into school for working outdoors. Please also supply your child with a water bottle that has their name on it to leave at school. They will bring this home every Friday.

Families and Homes



Class 4

Autumn 1

*This half-term we will be covering the topic of
'Families and Homes'*

English

This half term we will be looking at lots of stories around our topic of Families and Homes. We will be focusing on a different book every fortnight. Children will be working on letter formation and our Year Ones will be continuing to improve their sentence work.

Maths

Children will be looking at number and shape. They will focus on number bonds, counting, adding and subtraction.

Science

In science, Class 4 will be learning all about the properties of different materials. They will test how strong different materials are through the '3 Little Pigs' story.

Computing

In Computing, children will learn about the importance of e-safety. They will also continue to familiarise themselves with the computer equipment around school

History

In History this half term, we will be learning about the things that have changed in living memory. We will focus on technology, toys and houses.

Art

This half term, Class 4 will be creating lots of pictures of their family and homes. They will use a range of different techniques and tools and focus on their drawing skills.

SEAL

The SEAL topic this half term is New Beginnings. Children will be creating their own class charter and discussing how to become good role-models.

RE

This half term, the children will be listening to Bible stories and learning about Harvest.

PE

This half term Class 4 will begin to master basic movements including running, jumping, throwing and catching, as well as developing balance, agility and co-ordination through gymnastics and games.
