Homework will be given out in your child's homework book on a Friday and collected in on a Wednesday morning. It would be appreciated if you could take the time to help your child learn their spellings at home and access Spellodrome as each child receives an individual spelling pack, some children will be receiving two lots of spelling homework.

Literacy
