

Reception

Reception children will soon receive a set of flashcards including all the sounds that they have covered so far in phonics. Please go through these regularly with your child. If you would like any support, please look at your pack received at the phonics evening, or alternatively pop into school where we will be happy to help.

Your child can also record something they have done over the weekend on a page in their homework book. This could be a picture or a photograph or something that they have collected.

Year 1

Each week your child will receive:

Maths Homework

Reading

Spellings

Homework will be given out in your child's black homework book on a Friday and collected in on a Wednesday morning. Spellings are given out on a Wednesday for the Friday. It would be appreciated if you could take the time to help your child learn their spellings at home.

All children should also read at home whenever possible to an adult. This should be recorded in their planner. You could also pop a note in their planner if you have shared any other books at home. Reading bags and planners should be brought to school every day and taken home every night.

Reminder.

PE kits should be brought into school in a drawstring bag at the start of term and remain at school until the end of the half-term.

Children will also need to bring a pair of wellies into school for working outdoors. Please also supply your child with a water bottle that has their name on it to leave at school. They will bring this home every Friday.

Superheroes!



Class 4 Spring 1

*This half-term we will be covering the topic of
'Superheroes'*

English

This half term we will be focusing on books around the topic of 'Superheroes' Reception children will be continuing to learn new sounds and working on letter formation as well as beginning to write simple CVC words. Year 1s will be focusing on story plots and beginning to write stories with a beginning, middle and end. They will also write captions to accompany pictures

Maths

Children will be looking at number, place value and money. Year 1s will focus on adding and subtraction as well as beginning to tackle word problems including money.

Science

In science, Class 4 will be learning all about the human body. They will name parts of the body and learn about our senses. Year 1s will also plan and carry out simple investigations around this topic, including finding the best of our 'superhero' senses.

Computing

In Computing, children will continue to learn about algorithms and use the Bee-Bots to complete simple programs as well as dressing it up to become a villain that chases superheroes!

History

In History this half term, we will be looking at real-life sporting superheroes from the past and present. Children will also find out about the Olympic Games.

Art

This half term, Class 4 will be finding out about pop art. They will be looking at the artist Roy Lichtenstein and producing their own superhero-themed work using a similar technique.

SEAL

The SEAL topic this half term is 'Going for Goals'. Children will be discussing why we have goals for the future, as well as choosing a goal to try to achieve themselves.

RE

This half term, the children will be focusing on what it means to belong in Christianity. They will find out about baptism and visit St Ebba's.

PE

This half term Year 1s are lucky enough to have a dance coach to work with them ready for an upcoming dance festival. The children will also be taking part in team games as well as improving attacking and defending skills.
