Robin Hood



Class 1 Spring 2

***This term we will be covering the topic of
'Robin Hood.'***

***As part of this work Class One will be
planning and organising an activity morning
for the Infant children.***

Literacy

In English, Class One will be developing their story writing skills focusing upon their use of punctuation and vocabulary to write an exciting Robin Hood story. We will also consider the features of a balanced argument. Our class novel will be 'Outlaw' by Michael Morpurgo.

Maths

Class One will solve one-step and two-step problems involving whole numbers and decimals and all four operations. They will calculate the area and perimeter of rectangular shapes and read scales accurately. Class One will choose, use and record standard metric units to estimate and measure length, weight and capacity and will read time-tables using 24 hour clock notation.

Science

In science, Class One will be considering the life processes common to plants and the role of the leaf in producing new material for growth. We will describe how living things are classified into broad groups according to common observable characteristics and based on similarities and differences, including microorganisms, plants and animals.

Computing

This half term, Class One will be developing their understanding of computer networks. As part of the Digital Literacy curriculum, we will consider what cyberbullying is and how we can prevent it.

History

Class One will research what life was like in the time of the Normans. We will focus on Norman castles: how they were designed and why they were needed.

Geography

In geography, Class One will be considering how Robin Hood would find clean water to drink. We will be working on the water cycle and also developing our map reading skills.

DT

In DT this half term, Class One will be designing and making shelters in our woodland. They will consider how they can strengthen their structures and investigate the best materials to use to ensure the shelter is waterproof.

SEAL

The SEAL topic this half term is Good to be Me. Throughout this topic Class One will focus on understanding their feelings as well as considering their strengths and weaknesses as learners.

RE

This half term, Class One will consider why are Good Friday and Easter Day the most important days for Christians?

PE
