Each week your child will receive:
Maths Homework
Reading
Spellings. Y1

Homework will be given out in your child's homework book on a Friday and collected in on a Monday morning. Spellings will be given out on a Monday in preparation for a test on Friday. It would be appreciated if you could take the time to help your child learn their spellings at home.

Children should also read at home every night to an adult. This should be recorded in their planner. Reading bags and planners should be brought to school every day and taken home every night, reading books will be changed weekly.

Reminder.

PE kits should be brought into school in a drawstring bag at the start of term and remain at school until the end of term. This should include a T-shirt (not a football shirt), plain black shorts and plimsolls.

Children will also need to bring a pair of old outdoor shoes or wellies into school for working outdoors.

The Jungle



Literacy

Y1

As our topic is the The Jungle, this half term we will be reading books with a jungle theme and focusing on describing the character. We will also be looking at making lists and labels.

Reception

We will be learning how to hold our pencil correctly and focussing mainly on phonics which will eventually lead to blending and segmenting sounds to make words.

Maths

Year 1 children will be becoming increasingly familiar with numbers they will extending and applying their knowledge of number facts and begin to use standard written methods for addition and subtraction.

Reception will be counting on to the given number and finding one more/less than the given amount.

Science

During this half term, the children will be looking at the characteristics of animals. They will be comparing animals in the jungle to other animals and humans.

Year 1 will be exploring why belonging is important and how they belong to a group.

Reception will be learning about ways in which they are special and unique.

Geography

Class Four will be finding out about the places in the world where there are different jungles. They will be looking at different animals that live in the jungle.

P.E.
