

Results for 2018 - Impact of Pupil Premium

The cohort size for the EYFS this year is 7. 100% of pupils eligible for Pupil Premium achieved a Good Level of Development

There were 16 pupils who took the phonics test as part of the Y1 class. 2 Y2 pupils repeated the phonics test and one pupil reached the expected standard. 100% of children eligible for the Pupil Premium passed the screening.

The cohort size for the Year 2 class is 10. It can be seen that Pupil Premium children performed better than others in Reading and Writing but slightly lower in Maths. There were no Pupil Premium children who reached greater depth in Maths, Reading or Maths. It is worth noting that the cohort numbers are particularly small.

We have 14 pupils in our Year 6 group this year. Of these 14 pupils, 2 pupils are currently working bellowed the KS2 level. This means they were not entered into either the English reading or English grammar test. This has an impact on our data -and Pupil Premium results. The results for our Pupil Premium children are in line with national average for all subjects apart from writing.
