

Proposed Sports Premium Funding 2019/20



The sport premium is to be used to increase the quality & breadth of PE & Sport provision, and increasing participation in PE & Sport. At Ebchester School, we strive to promote healthy and active lifestyles and aim to provide sporting opportunities for all our pupils.

In addition, we believe that an innovative and varied PE curriculum and extra-curricular opportunities have a positive influence on the concentration, attitude and academic achievement of all children. Below is a breakdown of how we propose to spend the Sports Premium Funding for the academic year 2019/20

Sports premium allocation: £16,800

Aim	What we plan to do and why?	Impact and evidence
To promote physical activity through a wide and varied range of sports-based experiences for all pupils.	Each half term, children will have the opportunity to try a new and 'different' sporting activity. E.g. climbing, yoga, canoeing etc As well as promoting active lifestyles, this will add to childrens' experiences, perhaps prompting them to take up the activity outside of school. £5,000	
To increase participation in sporting competitions	Subsidise transport and administration costs. £2,000	
To increase participation levels in competitive sport	Stanley affiliation fees To allow a range of teams to play in inter-school competitions £100	
To ensure high quality lesson plans and assessment	Real PE Scheme of work and training. £2295	
Achieving high-quality PE	Replenishing PE equipment £500	
Broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils	Coaching sessions Offer an additional sporting activity after-school club.	

	Continue to target children who wouldn't usually attend a sports based after-school club. Club to change every half term. (AE coaching) £1,000	
To increase physical and adventurous activity through outdoor learning and experiences	Forest School sessions for all pupils. Suitable outdoor clothing. £500	
To increase physical activity across the curriculum	Active learning training, maths/literacy etc £1000	
Broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils	Subsidise outdoor adventurous activities which would not be otherwise available. (Robinwood) £3000	

Total: £15,395

This leaves a contingency of £1405 to deal with any emergencies or additional spend.
